

**NOTICE OF FIRST PUBLIC HEARING
ERIE COUNTY
FY 2011 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

The County of Erie anticipates receiving approximately \$450,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for Fiscal Year 2011 from the PA Department of Community and Economic Development.

County CDBG funds are to be used to help non-entitlement municipalities undertake projects which address community development and housing needs which primarily benefit low-to-moderate income families. Eligible projects include such activities as water, sanitary sewer and storm sewer construction; road improvements; curb and sidewalk replacement; handicapped accessibility improvements; and housing rehabilitation.

A public hearing to discuss possible projects is scheduled for Thursday, August 12, 2010 from 6:00 PM to 6:30 PM in the Admiral Room of the Raymond M. Blasco Memorial Library, 160 East Front Street, Erie, PA.
