

**NOTICE OF FINAL PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD
FY 2011 ERIE COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that the County of Erie intends to make application to the PA Department of Community and Economic Development (PA DCED) for FY 2011 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$633,252 to undertake housing and community development activities which will primarily benefit low-to-moderate income families in various municipalities in Erie County. The County is eligible to apply for the grant monies under the provisions of PA Act 179 of 1984.

In accordance with the Act, the grant monies are to be disbursed as follows:
\$339,843 to Erie County to benefit non-entitlement municipalities
\$101,287 to Girard Township
\$96,151 to McKean Township
\$95,971 to North East Borough

Based upon public needs hearings and municipal funding requests it is proposed that the grant monies be used to undertake the following activities:

Erie County

\$100,000- Cranesville Borough Bowman Avenue Water Line Replacement Project
\$100,000- Lake City Borough Dunn Ave. / Elk St. Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project
\$ 78,843- Weslyville Borough Willow Street Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project
\$ 61,000- Program Administration

Girard Township

\$96,735.75- Gloskey Road Culvert Replacement Project (*reimbursement for costs*)
\$ 4,551.25- Program Administration

McKean Township

\$78,844- Single Family Housing Rehabilitation Project
\$10,107- Update to Comprehensive Plan
\$ 7,200- Program Administration

North East Borough

\$ 88,771- Clinton Street Water Line Replacement Project
\$ 7,200- Program Administration

Citizens may comment on the proposed activities at a public hearing to be held by Erie County Council at 6:00 PM, Tuesday, October 4, 2011 in the Erie County Council Caucus Room- Room 117, located at the Erie County Court House, 140 West 6th Street, Erie PA 16501.

The comment period is from September 5th to the day of the hearing, October 4, 2011. County Planning is the administrative agent for the County's CDBG funds as well as the CDBG funds of Girard, McKean, and North East Borough.
